Curriculum/approach description

The Master Stedenbouw en Ruimtelijke Planing (STeR) - Master Urban Design and Spatial Planning is a 120 ECTS program that is accredited by the Flemish government. It is a program that relies on research as well as professional input. The masters degree gives access to the profession of accredited spatial planner in Flanders, as well to the office of municipal and regional planner ('gemeentelijk en gewestelijk stedenbouwkundig ambtenaar'). It also gives access to PhD or other research positions. The STeR program occupies a unique position in the landscape of spatial planning programs in Flanders and Belgium, as it is located within the Department of Geography, and in the metropolitan context of the Brussels Capital Region. The program thus benefits from input in terms of teaching and research from the fields of social and urban geography, in addition to planning and urbanism theory, landscape studies, urban sociology and spatial design, and takes the complex spatial and institutional context of the Brussels Capital Region and its wider metropolitan area as a main focus of study. The research of the academic staff is grouped in Cosmopolis Centre for Urban Research, an interdisciplinary research centre that also coordinates Urban Studies research throughout the Vrije Universiteit Brussel.

| Curriculum/approach description | <p>4Cities, UNICA Euromaster in urban studies is a two-year interdisciplinary and international programme run by Vrije Universiteit Brussel, Université Libre de Bruxelles, Universitat Wien, Kobenhavns Universitet, Universidad Autonoma de Madrid and Universidad Complutense de Madrid. 4Cities students spend one semester in Brussels, Copenhagen, Vienna and Madrid respectively, and in a number of surrounding cities. This program adds a European perspective to the field of Urban Studies: it wants to break up and to open the national perspective on urban problems. It focuses on glocalisation, Europe as a unit of analysis, and takes a strong interdisciplinary approach. Teaching relies strongly on international comparative studies taking the host cities as rich and diverse cases of study. 4Cities has been selected as from the academic year 2013-2014 onwards as an Erasmus Mundus Master Course (EMMC).</p> | | | | |

| Curriculum/approach description | <p>Academic staff at Cosmopolis Centre for Urban Research supervises PhD research in the fields of urban studies, urban design and spatial planning. Vrije Universiteit Brussel as well as other Belgian universities have rather loosely organized doctoral schools with minimal requirements in terms of courses and ECTS. In addition to general doctoral training courses offered at university level, PhD research within the field of urban studies and spatial planning is closely monitored in Cosmopolis Research Seminars. Cosmopolis hosts both Belgian and international PhD students on scholarships and within research projects (funded by national funding agencies such as FWO, Innoviris, IWT and international scholarships from EU, development cooperation programs and (inter)university programs among others).</p> | | | | |
